

How to Care for Your Flame and Acid-Resistant Clothing (e.g D59 Garments)

Your flame- and acid-resistant clothing protects you from serious dangers. To keep it working properly, you need to look after it carefully. Follow these steps every time:

Before You Wear It

- Check your garment every day before putting it on.
- Look for damage like holes, burns, or tears.
- If you see any damage, stop using it and get a new one.

Washing Your Protective Clothing

   Do this:	   Don't do this:
 ASAP: Treat oily or greasy marks Use a light cleaning soap (e.g. green Sunlight bar).	 Do NOT wash with everyday normal clothes!     <i>If you mix with normal clothes it will make your safety clothing unsafe.</i>
 Wash in warm water (not hot) with a mild detergent (gentle soap) e.g Omo, Skip, Ariel.	 Do NOT use bleach (Check ingredients list for: Hypochlorite bleach).
 Rinse well to remove all the soap and cleaning agents.	 Do NOT use Sta-Soft
 Iron after washing. <i>This helps to restore the special protective finish.</i>	 Do NOT hang in direct sunlight to dry.
	 Do NOT tumble dry
